


New Tutor Information


Firstly, thank you for taking the time to learn about our business with us at Core+ Tuition, we know as a tutor you have many choices and we are very grateful you are considering working with us.

- ID uploaded
- DBS Certificate uploaded
- DBS Number
- DBS Update Service confirmation
- Evidence of Safeguarding training within 12 months
- TRN (if applicable)
- CV uploaded
- Copies of relevant qualifications uploaded
- Proof of insurance uploaded -Public Liability (in person tutors only) and Professional Indemnity
- References at least one professional

Working with Core+

Tutor Pay

As a self-employed contractor you set your rate that you charge us.
Currently our tutors are charging us between £28 and £32 for a qualified teacher delivering 1:1 GCSE.

Payment

We take payment from clients in half term blocks in advance and pay tutors in arrears at the end of the half term. Our business model ensures you are never sat in front of a student without payment! By using TutorCruncher we have removed the need for you to raise invoices, we will raise a payment order from the sessions you've marked complete.

Content of sessions

As a self employed tutor you have full autonomy over your delivery and content. We trust you as a professional but we are also hear to support and signpost should you need that.

Cancelling & Moving

You have flexibility to move and book additional sessions directly with the client, we just ask that you do this through TutorCruncher and we will give you guidance on how to do this. Alternatively we can deal with all bookings and movement if you are more comfortable.

Communication

We maintain communication with clients and tutors to ensure everyone is happy with arrangements and liaise with parties when needed.

As a self-employed tutor we would recommend you hold Professional Indemnity Insurance for all tutors and Public Liability if you are tutoring in person.

How long are sessions?

Our standard session length is 50 minutes however there are times where this is amended due to student or client requirements for example A-Level is usually 1 hour.

How much should I be looking to pay for insurance?

As a sole trader policies for both Public Liability and Professional Indemnity insurance should be in the region of £100 to £150. I definitely recommend that you shop around and make sure that the policy covers you sufficiently.

How does payment work?

By using TutorCruncher we take the admin out of getting payment for you. Once you have finished a lesson all you have to do is mark it complete on TutorCruncher and then the system will create a Payment Order (Invoice) for you at the end of each Half Term this will then be sent to you via Bank Transfer.

What happens if I need to cancel a session?

You contact the client as soon as is reasonably possible (or contact myself and I can contact them for you). If you are able to please try to rearrange any 1:1 sessions at a mutually convenient time - then log in to TutorCruncher and click on edit session to move it on the system.

If you are unable to rearrange log on to TutorCruncher and mark the session as Cancelled. The client will receive credit and you will not receive any payment for that session.

What happens if a client cancel a session?

You contact the client as soon as is reasonably possible (or contact myself and I can contact them for you). If you are able to please try to rearrange any 1:1 sessions at a mutually convenient time (but you have no obligation to do this) - if moving it log in to TutorCruncher and click on edit session to move it on the system.

If you are unable to rearrange log on to TutorCruncher and mark the session as Cancelled but payable. The client will still be charged and you will receive your payment for that session.

Can I claim for any expenses?

If travelling over 3 miles to a student we will amend the session rate we are paying you to reflect the cost and time travelling.

As a self-employed contractor you are responsible for any other expenses (Tax, NI, Resources, Printing etc)
